


## MOIS to PowerChart Care Plan Distribution

### Important Information

1. Clients must match in Cerner and MOIS on 6 fields: First Name, Last Name, Date of Birth, Gender, PHN and Insurance Type (By)
2. Only Shared Careplans are accepted by PowerChart at this time. No other EMR to EMR documents will be received into the chart.
3. The recipient to send to is **NH PowerChart**
4. You must have EMR to EMR turned on to be able to send Shared Care Plans.

In order for the Shared Care Plan to match to the correct client in PowerChart your client must have this information in their MOIS Chart prior to distributing the Care Plan

1. Registered with 6 key fields

2. Press 'Distribute' from the Care Plan Folder
  - a) Choose a Letterhead type
  - b) Add a note for the snap shot, ie. Sent to PowerChart
  - c) Ensure Author is correct
  - d) Add recipient: NH PowerChart
  - e) Add Diagnosis. Note this does not show up in PowerChart
  - f) Press Distribute
3. Create Distribution window will open – Press 'Distribute(F2)'

“Shared Care Plan (2019-02-04)” will be added in the Patient banner bar in PowerChart. To view the Care Plan navigate to the “Document Viewing” folder.
