

## Documenting in Preferences

### **Consent:**

Automated Call Service (Inphonite) -> Consent -> Other (Patient does want calls from Inphonite)  
Office Internal Consent Forms -> Consent -> Other

### **Directive:**

HIV Screening -> Directive -> Measure  
No colonoscopy -> Directive -> Procedure  
Decline Weights -> Directive -> Measure  
Decline Vaccines -> Directive -> Medication  
Pap -> Directive -> Not Desired -> Self Choice (Patient does not want a pap test)  
TB Skin Test -> Directive -> Not Desired -> Self Choice (if the patient chooses not to have the test)  
Narcotic Contract -> Directive -> Other

### **Disclosure:**

Shared Information (with Lawyer) -> Disclosure -> Other (or Consult)  
Pharmanet -> Disclosure -> Other  
ROI - Release of Information.

### **Advance Directive:**

LOI (Level of Intervention) -> Advance Directive -> Other [MOST Form]

### **Not Indicated:**

Mammogram -> Not indicated -> Previous Procedure -> Imaging [Reason: Double Mastectomy]  
DM Foot Exam -> Not Indicated -> Previous Procedure -> Other [Reason: Double Amputation]  
Pap -> Not indicated -> Previous Procedure -> Measure [Reason: Hysterectomy]  
Hepatitis B Vaccination -> Not Indicated -> Measure [Reason: Someone who has already been infected with live virus.]

### **Contraindication:**

MRI for persons with pacemakers, metallic stents or intracranial or intraorbital metal objects  
Phlebotomy from arm containing dialysis shunt or the breast cancer survivor with lymphedema  
Beta blocker medication for those with severe asthma  
Grapefruit and drugs whose metabolism is affected by grapefruit - e.g. statins, calcium channel blockers  
Excessive sun exposure when on photosensitizing drugs such as tetracyclines  
Working at heights or driving with unstable seizure disorder  
Climbing ladders with ankle fusion  
Live vaccine when immune-compromised  
Severe claustrophobia MRI upper part of body without sedation  
Pregnancy (for live vaccines)  
Anaphylactic reaction to previous dose of vaccine or antigen  
Anaphylactic Reaction to a vaccine component (except latex)  
History of Intussusception (for Rotavirus)  
Family History of Congenital Immunodeficiency.  
BP on the affected side when a mastectomy has been performed  
Do not take a BP on the arm which has or is reserved for a fistula/dialysis treatments.

MRSA -> Precaution  
Syncope (fainting) -> Precaution -> Other
